Dear Stewart Descendants,

The Annual Reunion of the Walter Stewart Clan will be held during the weekend of August 10-11, 2002 at Fairview Presbyterian Church in Fountain Inn, S.C. We hope you will join us for the family sharing and tour on Saturday and the traditional reunion meeting and picnic dinner on Sunday.

We will meet at the Fairview Church community building near Fountain Inn for our Saturday morning registration, for the afternoon tour, and for our catered supper Saturday night. The reunion business meeting will be at Fairview Church on Sunday morning, with a picnic afterwards on the church grounds - or inside, in case of rain.

Vans will be provided for those who would like to go on the Saturday afternoon tour. We have something different this year: a visit to a corn maze owned by one of our cousins in the House of Samuel, 174 Jack T. Stewart of Enoree, SC. Jack and his daughter and son-in-law, Angie and Greg Broome, created the maze (or MAIZE, as they call it) with the help of a professional designer. A gamecock, tiger paw and the words "Gamecock" and "Tigers" are incorporated in the pattern. This should certainly appeal to our youngsters and sports fans. We also plan a drive-by tour of old Stewart family homeplaces, with a tour of one of the older restored homes in the area.

Saturday night, we will gather for our family supper at the Fairview Presbyterian Church community building. This is a time of fellowship, renewing family ties, and sharing of family news and pictures. We would like to continue collecting old pictures for our Walter Stewart family website, thanks to webmistress Judy Lesslie and her helpers - LaMarr Brooks, Robert Hall, and my own young grandson and computer whiz Andrew McClure. Thanks to this group, and members of the family who have brought in their old pictures and records for scanning, we have greatly enhanced the family archives. We hope to continue the project at this and future reunions. Be sure to bring in your pictures, clippings and old letters for free on-the-spot scanning by our experts.

On Sunday morning we will join the Fairview congregation for their regular 11:00 worship service, after which we will have our clan business meeting. Consider coming early while it's cool to tour Fairview's interesting rock walled cemetery. The oldest marked grave is 1794, and there are about 750 graves. The original rock wall was built by slaves about 1850, and enlarged in 1930. The men of Fairview have always been a patriotic group, and veterans of every war in the nation's history are buried there, except for those of the Gulf War, who are still living.

The family historians ask that you continue to send in new births, marriages and deaths in your family. Please see the update sheets elsewhere in this newsletter for information on how to submit this data for your family.

We look forward to seeing you during Stewart reunion weekend to renew old ties and celebrate new ones. As it has for many decades, the goes out call still, bring a full picnic basket and join us!

NOTE FROM THE CHIEF HISTORIAN – Mary S. Rawlinson

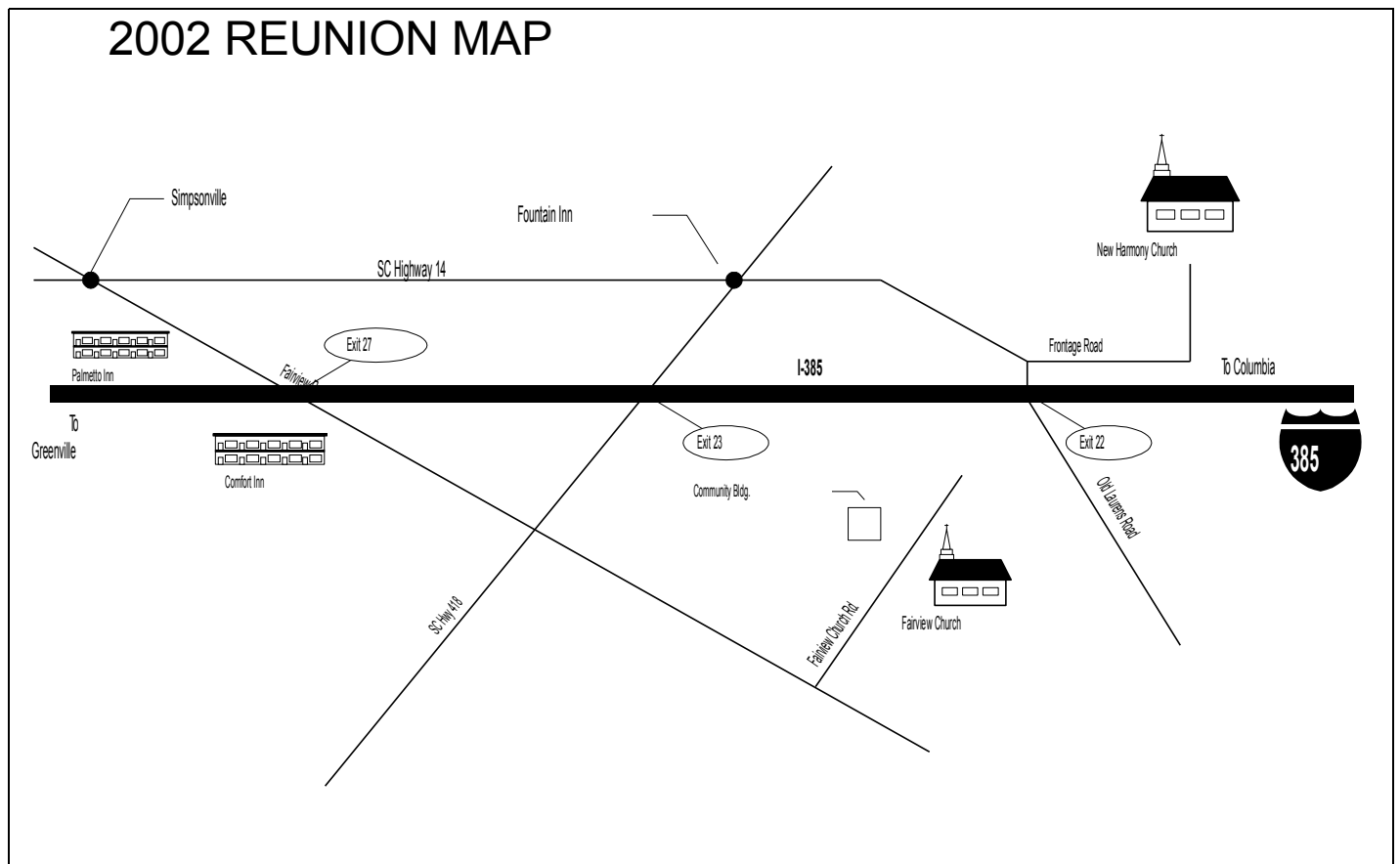
I've thought for a long time that Stewart descendants are globetrotters, but it's still a great pleasure to get such wonderful proof down through the years. A hundred years and more ago our ancestors wrote letters home about encountering their cousins on the western frontiers. Now they're doing the same in foreign countries! Here is a touching story sent to me by 64165 Beth Rickenbaker of Orangeburg, SC:

A couple of weeks ago I had an amazing experience. I was on a mission trip with my church, First Presbyterian Church of Orangeburg, in Iquitos, Peru. On the last night of our trip in Iquitos on the Amazon River our group went out to dinner. We were joined by the pastor of the church we sponsor and his family and two young Americans who live in Iquitos for the summer and act as hosts and greeters for the various groups who come down to work for Medical Missions. I overheard the young man, Todd, say that he is from Fountain Inn, SC. So, I asked him if he knew of Fairview Presbyterian Church. He said all of his ancestors are buried there and I said mine are too. It turns out we are both descended from Clark Berry Stewart. His name is Todd Garrett and his grandmother was Mary Lou Garrett. My mother, Margaret Stewart Rickenbaker and Mary Lou were second cousins.

Meeting Todd in Iquitos, Peru while we were both on a mission made me very proud of our heritage and of the work people like you and his grandmother have done to preserve our history so that we could sit together at a table in a foreign country and know where we came from.

Neither one of us will be able to make in to reunion this year, but I am very thankful for the heritage we share and I hope to be there next year.
