LETTER FROM THE CHIEF

Dear Stewart Descendants,

Family Mailing List Enhancements

The Stewart mailing list has been greatly enhanced since last year. We all know and love the famous Stewart codes, which provides a unique number for every Stewart descendant...but there has been a problem in this day of computer databases with those family members who are the 10th or higher child in their families...because those Stewart codes don't sort numerically with their families. For instance, family member 1239 and his sibling 123.10. end up at very different places in a list sorted by code, because of the decimal place in the sibling's code. And the problem is even worse when more than one person in a line of ancestry was the 10th or higher child, since that means two or three or more decimals in a code. This problem was solved by setting up a "sorting" Stewart code, with 1=A, 2=B...10=J, 11=K, etc. So our hypothetical siblings now have "sorting codes" of ABCI and ABCJ...which sort perfectly into family groupings. That may seem trivial, but when you are doing your level best to avoid duplicates and address errors, it matters a lot! Other enhancements made this year are for the addition of fields for email addresses, phone numbers, a flag to send or not send the annual newsletter, and attendance by year. So hats off to 317142 Linda Clark and 317143 Judy Smith for their hard work on these improvements in the past year!

While on the subject of the mailing list...we try to keep track of everybody by asking the Postal Service to notify us of address changes, but sometimes this isn't available, and it always costs us extra money even to find that out.
