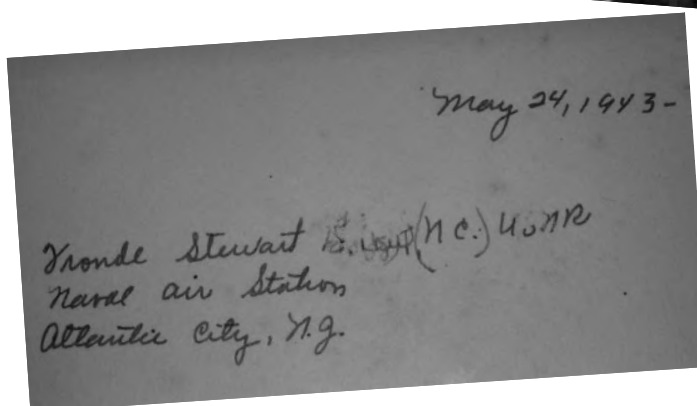
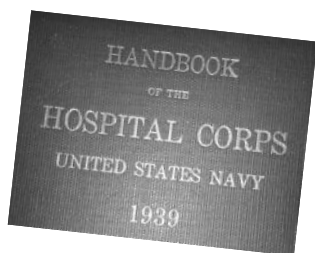

The 109th Reunion of the Walter Stewart Clan was held the weekend of August 13th & 14th 2016 at Bethany Presbyterian Church, 106 Fawn Rd., Clinton, SC. The Clan Business Meeting was held at 12:15 pm in the church sanctuary. 38213 Mary Kramer played a tribute to Chief Charles B. Stewart, Amazing Grace, on the bagpipes. 31712 Chief Charles B. Stewart opened the meeting with a prayer and Hymn #435, What a Friend We Have in Jesus, accompanied by 317651 Cathy Tollison on the piano. Chief Charles commented that it gladdens his heart to see so many of our kinfolk, cousins, and friends come together. Chief Charles announced that he would be stepping down as the Chief of the Walter Stewart Clan this year and we will elect a new chief. He requested that his son, Assistant Chief, 317121 Dick Stewart, lead the business meeting. The Assistant Chief requested members present from each house to stand for count. Numbers recorded:

The youngest in attendance was 322221112 Emma Grace Jones and the oldest in attendance was Chief Charles at age 93. The least number of digits in attendance was 38213 Carl & Mary Kramer. In attendance for the first time: 3222231 Todd Stewart and guests Liz Tennant and Martha Whitney Bellows.

Chief Historian, 31714 Mary Newton commented that we are out of sequence in our church rotation due to Fairview's renovations; next year we would return to Fairview. She reported that 41 were in attendance at the Saturday meal. Lawrence Young spoke at the meal due to the Laurens Museum cancelation.

The 2015 Business minutes given by secretary, 351231 LaMarr Brooks, were voted to accept without additions or corrections.

A treasurer's report was given by Les & Valerie Jones. Beginning balance was \$4062.23. Income of \$707.00 was received from reunion week-end and newsletter. Expenses of \$1446.32 were incurred for reunion week-end and newsletter, leaving an ending balance of \$3322.91. The collection plate was passed.

317141 Alan Fields, Nominating Committee Chair, submitted the nominations for the Officers 2016–2017 term. All nominations were accepted, keeping the previous Officers: Chief Historian, Mary Stewart Newton; Treasurers, Valerie & Les Jones; and Secretary, LaMarr Brooks.

Report of the Special Nominating Committee was given by Chairperson, Linda Lesslie Clark. The Committee members consisted of Tommy Brooks, Valerie Stewart Jones, Anne Shaver, and James M. Stewart, Jr. The committee diligently considered possible nominees to be the successor Chief of the Walter Stewart Clan. The new Chief must be a direct descendant (male or female) of Walter Stewart and is elected for life. After serious consideration, the committee reached a unanimous decision to nominate 317143 Judith Lesslie Smith as Chief of the Walter Stewart Clan. The nomination was unanimously approved by vote of the family. Assistant Chief Dick Stewart ceremonially presented the medal of office for the Chief of the Walter Stewart Clan to Judith Lesslie Smith, niece of Chief Charles and granddaughter of the late Chief Tinsley Stewart.
